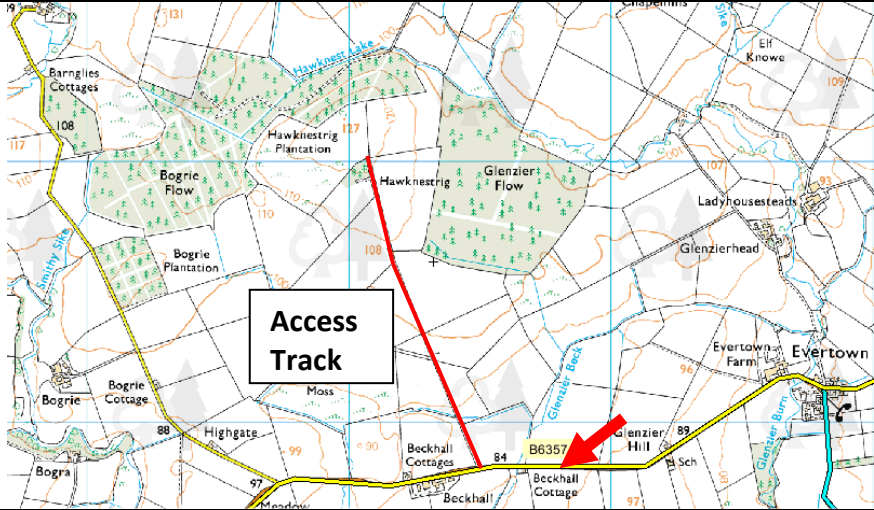


Timber Transport Management Plan **Dumfries & Galloway**
