

U400n Shinnel Glen - Timber Haulage Rules Revised July 2018

- Maximum permissible number of loads – 6 per day (Monday – Friday only)
- The daily permissible number of loads will be reduced to 3 per day (Monday – Friday only) during the winter (December – March). Where necessary, this restriction will be implemented earlier, especially during periods of bad weather, to help protect the structure of the road.
- Timber lorries are NOT permitted to use the haulage route before 06:00.
- Timber lorries to adhere to the signed 20mph speed restrictions at all times.
- Extra care should be taken when passing properties and speed reduced.
- The use of roof mounted spotlights is prohibited on the timber haulage route.
- Lorries can travel in pairs when empty but must be 10 minutes apart when loaded on the way back down.
- Drivers MUST stop and check the security / strapping of their load at the forest gate before proceeding onto the tarmac road.
- Timber lorries are NOT permitted to use the timber haulage route after 18:30.
